

关于新加坡移民局将对不符合入境条件者 实施“禁载令”的通知

各运输航空公司、各国际机场，民航局国际合作服务中心：

近期，新加坡外交部照会包括中国在内的各国驻新加坡使团告，新移民局将于 2026 年 1 月底起在樟宜机场和实里达机场实施“禁载令”（No-Boarding Directive），以阻止不符合入境条件的旅客登上赴新航班，并要求各航司配合执行。“禁载令”对象主要包括：被禁止的移民；带来安全风险、公众健康风险或影响航班安全的人员；不符合新签证或准证获取资格的人员。新移民局官网称，该“禁载令”将于 2026 年 1 月 30 日起生效。

据了解，新移民局已提前通报各航司，确保“禁载令”顺利实施。届时新移民局将筛查航司提供的拟登机旅客信息并针对不

符合入境条件者向航司签发“禁载令”。这部分旅客在办理登机手续时，就会被收到“禁载令”通知的航司拒绝登机。被拒绝旅客可通过新移民局的反馈渠道致函申诉，得到入境许可后方可下次乘机赴新。如果航司人员因故意或疏忽导致被拒绝旅客成功登机，将被判处最高1万新元罚款和/或最长6个月监禁。

请各运输航空公司、国际机场参见上述新移民局要求，做好工作准备，及时通知旅客及有关驻场单位。请民航局国际合作服务中心通知相关外国航空公司以及国际航空运输协会（IATA）在华代表处。

The Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the Republic of Singapore presents its compliments to all Diplomatic Missions, Consular Missions and International Organisations accredited to the Republic of Singapore and has the honour to inform that the Immigration and Checkpoints Authority (ICA) will be implementing No Boarding Directive (NBD) to all airlines, including cargo and private charters, operating from Changi and Seletar Airport from January 2026 onwards.

The Ministry has the further honour to update that with the above-mentioned initiative, NBD may be issued to Permanent Residents (PRs), Long Term Pass (LTP) holders and foreign visitors who, as the case may be, (a) are prohibited immigrants; (b) pose a security or public health risk to Singapore and might compromise the safety of persons in the aircraft if allowed boarding; or (c) would be ineligible for a pass or permit to enter Singapore, including foreign visitors whose presence in Singapore would be undesirable and those without proper documents such as a valid Singapore visa or valid passport with a validity period of more than six months.

Airlines are expected to deny boarding of travellers issued with NBD. Travellers who have been denied boarding will be required to submit an appeal via ICA_Feedback@ica.gov.sg for approval before booking another flight to Singapore.
